


PDF Cover Page Designs


You can print your presentations in a sleek and uniform design. In those presentations you have a number of options for designs for your cover page! Follow the instructions below and learn how to set your cover page design in your PDF presentations!

How to select a cover page design!


1. From your Pages tab, select the settings wheel on your cover page.




2. From the connected panel, select the **Change** button.



- From here you can see all the options you have for your PDF cover page.
- Select the **Select** button on the design you would like to use.



- To see the PDF cover page, select the drop down menu in the top right corner, and select **Print View**.



6. You will now see your PDF cover page!
