Embedding a Google Map to Your Presentation

1. Search your desired area in Google Maps and select **Share**.





2. Navigate to Embed a Map and select Copy HTML.



3. Navigate to the presentation you want to add the map to and click the **Pencil Icon** to edit.



4. From the **Pages tab**, select **Add Page** on the top left and chose **Create New**.



5. From the pop-up, choose **Build Page**.
